

Maundy Thursday: This day takes its name from the Latin 'Mandatum' – Command, in remembrance of Jesus' command to his Apostles to love and serve one another. Today in our Cathedral the priests of the Diocese will gather with the Bishop to renew their priestly commitment. At that Mass also, the Holy Oils for use in the Diocese throughout the year will be blessed. Hence the name: *The Chrism Mass*.

In St C church that evening at 7:30pm we shall recall the institution of the Eucharist by our Lord and how He linked this with service by washing the feet of his Apostles. Some people will have their feet washed at the Mass. After this Mass, there will be 'watching' at the Altar of Repose in memory of the time spent by Christ in the Garden of Gethsemane. Watching will conclude with Night Prayer at 9.30pm

Good Friday: Today we celebrate the Passion and Death of our Lord. We follow his path with Stations of the Cross at 9am at OLA and Veneration of the Relic of the True Cross. Then, at St C at 3pm we enter into the Solemn Liturgy of his Passion.

Holy Saturday: The day when the Church waits, waits in hope of Christ's Resurrection. The Easter Vigil begins at 7.30pm. In this Vigil, when we celebrate Christ rising from the dead, all things are made new. We bless fire, light and water; we proclaim the Gospel of the Resurrection, we renew our own Baptismal Promises. We sing 'Alleluia' as we celebrate the first Mass of Easter and receive the Risen Lord in Holy Communion.

NB This year the Parish will celebrate the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday & Easter Vigil) at St Cuthbert's Church.
