FIRST SUNDAY IN LENT



Today the first full week of Lent begins, it is a good time (if we have not already done so), to enter into the spirit of Lent so that we grow closer to God. Of course, we have to expect that we will be tempted away from our good resolutions. Look at the way Jesus, in today's Gospel, was tempted as he prepared in the wilderness to begin his public life. He just resolutely carried on going forward. That is our model too, even if we stumble, we can pick ourselves up and carry on along the path to God.

2026 is officially designated as *the Year of St. Francis of Assisi, a Franciscan Jubilee Year* running from Jan 10, 2026, - Jan 10, 2027, marking the 800th anniversary of the saint's death. It commemorates the 13th-century saint's life, with major events including the public display of his remains.
