THE SOLEMNITY OF THE HOLY TRINITY

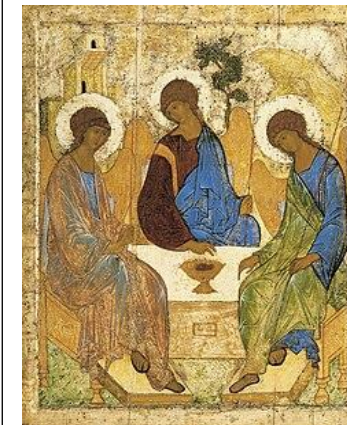


In today's liturgy a great mystery is set before us: the Blessed Trinity.
